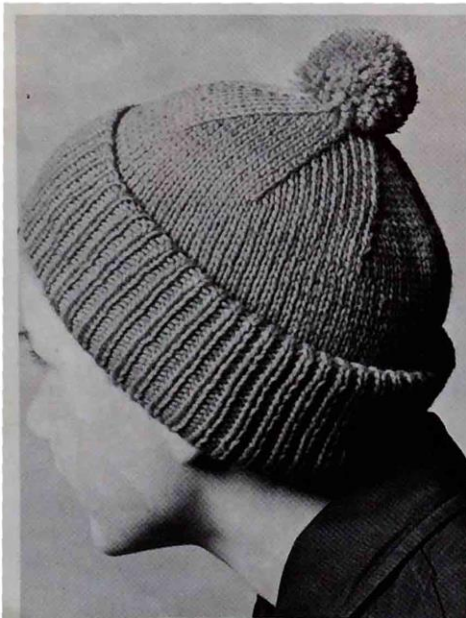


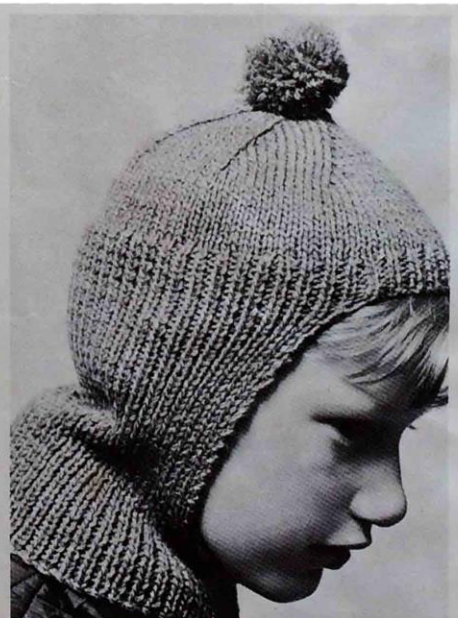


≡ BALACLAVA (SWISS CAP—HELMET) ≡

REQUIRES 2 X 50G BALLS DOUBLE-KNIT
TO FIT 12-16 YRS (AVERAGE HEAD)



Worn as Cap, with brim up.



Worn as Helmet, with brim down.

Swiss Cap-Helmet

With the brim worn up it is a cap and with the brim worn down it is a helmet. To fit boys of 12 to 16 years

To fit	Average head
Patons Trident Double Knitting	× 50 gram balls 2
Patons Double Knitting	× 50 gram balls 2

Two No. 8 BEEHIVE needles measured by BEEHIVE gauge, or MILWARDS DISC needles.

Tension

11 sts. and 15 rows to two square inches on No. 8 needles measured over stocking stitch.

See page 8 for how to check your Tension, and Abbreviations.

This Cap has been specially designed for the size given and it is regretted that no other adaptations are available.

Cast on 109 sts.

1st row—K.2, * P.1, K.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

2nd row—* K.1, P.1, rep. from * to last st., K.1.

Rep. these 2 rows until work measures $3\frac{1}{4}$ ins. from beg.

Divide work as follows:—

Next row—Rib 43, cast off 23, rib to end.

Continue in rib on **each** group of 43 sts. until work measures $7\frac{3}{4}$ ins. from beg.

Next row—Rib 43, cast on 23, rib to end.

Continue in rib until work measures $8\frac{3}{4}$ ins. from beg.

Next row—K.2, (K.6, K.2 tog.) 13 times, K.3 (96 sts.).

Next row—P.

Work in stocking stitch for $2\frac{1}{4}$ ins.

Shape crown as follows:—

1st row—(K.10, K.2 tog.) 8 times.

2nd and alt. rows—P.

3rd row—(K.9, K.2 tog.) 8 times.

Continue dec. in this manner on every alt. row until 8 sts. remain.

Thread yarn through remaining sts. and fasten off. securely.

TO MAKE UP

Using a flat seam for ribbing and a fine back-stitch seam for remainder, join seam. Make a small pompon and attach to centre of crown.
