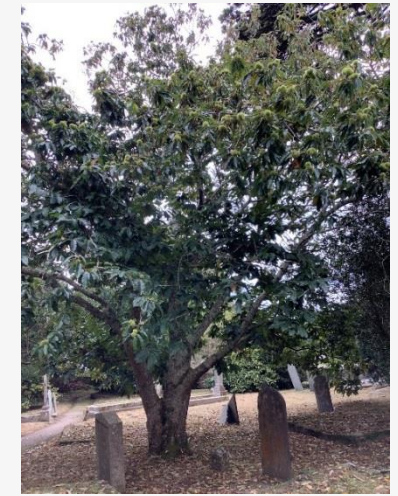
My bright berries add autumn
